Front







Key Functions - Front

- 1. Camera Lens: The lens of the built-in camera.
- 2. Front Screen: Shows signal and battery strength, time, day, and date, plus calls or message notifications.

Key Functions - Sides

- 1. Strap Attachment: Attach an optional strap (not included).
- 2. 2.5 mm Headset Jack: Plug in an optional headset for music, or for safe, convenient conversations.
- 3. Camera Key: From the Home screen, press to activate the Camera. When using Camera, press to take a photo.
- 4. Speakerphone Key: With the flip open, press and hold to activate the Speakerphone. With the flip closed, press and hold to activate Voice Commands, or press 4 times to initiate a Fake Call.
- 5. Cover Release Latch: Pull here with your finger to remove the battery cover.
- Charging/Accessory Port: Plug in charging accessories, and connect compatible accessory cables.
- Volume Key: Press to adjust Volume. Press Down to silence an incoming call ringtone. From the Home screen, press and hold Down to switch between Sound Off and the previous Volume level.

Key Functions - Open

- 1. Earpiece: Allows you to hear the caller.
- 2. Main Screen: Displays phone features.
- 3. Voicemail Key: Press to access voicemail.
- Right Soft Key: Press to select the command at the lower right area of the display screen.
- 5. Messaging Key: Press to access the Messaging menu.
- 6. End/Power Key: Press to end a call. Press and hold to turn the phone On or Off.
- 7. Vibrate Mode Key: Press and hold to activate Vibrate Mode.
- 8. Voice Commands Key: Press and hold for Voice Commands.
- Clear Key: Press to delete numbers or characters from the display, or to return to the previous item or screen.
- Send Key: Press to place or receive a call. From the Home screen, press once to access the All Calls log.
- 11. In Case of Emergency (ICE) Key: Press to access stored emergency numbers and information.
- Left Soft Key: Press to select the command at the lower left area of the display screen.
- Directional and OK Keys: Press left, right, up and down to scroll lists or screens, or to select a highlighted item.

Getting started

Installing the battery

- 1. Hold the phone firmly and locate the Cover Release Latch.
- 2. Firmly "pop" the cover off the phone.
- 3. Insert the battery into the phone, aligning the goldcontacts on the battery with the gold contacts in the phone.
- 4. Align the cover and press it into place, making sure it snaps securely.



Removing the battery

- Hold the phone firmly and locate the Cover Release Latch.
- 2. Firmly "pop" the cover off the phone.
- **3.** Lift the battery from the bottom end (see arrow 1) and remove.
- Align the cover and press it into place, making sure it snaps securely.



Charging the battery

1. Insert the charger cable into the Charging/Accessory port.



- 2. Plug the charging head into a standard AC power outlet.
- When charging is complete, unplug the charging head from the power outlet and remove the cable from the phone.

Turning Your Phone On/Off

Turning on/off your phone:

 Press and hold the End/Power Key to turn the phone on or off.



Adjusting Backlight

- From the Home screen, press the Left Soft Key
 Menu > Settings > Display > Backlight.
- 2. Choose **Display** to make selections for the LCD display's backlight:
 - Duration: Set the length of time the backlight is illuminated, from 7 seconds, 15 seconds, 30 seconds or Always On.
 - Brightness: Press the Directional Key Left or Right to adjust the brightness.
- Choose Keypad to make selections for the keypad backlight. choose from 7 Seconds, 15 Seconds, 30 Seconds, Always On or Always Off.
- 4. Press SET to save your settings.

Adjusting Volume

Use the Volume Key to adjust volume:

- From the Home screen, press the **Volume Key** to set Master Volume.
- From the Home screen, press and hold the Volume Key down to activate Sounds Off/Normal mode.
- During calls, press the Volume Key to adjust voice volume.
- During music playback, press the **Volume Key** to adjust audio volume.
- Press the **Volume Key** to mute the ringtone of an incoming call.
- If Fake Call is enabled, press the Volume Key down 4 times with the flip closed to initiate a Fake Call.

Turning Bluetooth On/Off

- From the Home screen, press the Left Soft Key
 Menu > Settings > Bluetooth.
- 2. Press the Left Soft Key Set On or Set Off.

Accessing Internet

- From the Home screen, press the Directional Key Left.
- or -

From the Home screen, press the **Left Soft Key** >

Making Calls

Your phone offers multiple ways to make calls:

- Enter the phone number or speed dial number, then press the SEND Send Key.
- · Call a contact from Contacts.
- Return a call, or call a recent caller via Recent Calls.
- · Voice dial using Voice Commands.

Answering Calls

You can answer calls with either the flip open or closed.

- · With the flip closed, open to answer automatically.
- With the flip open, press the Send Key.

Answering Call-Waiting Calls

When you receive a call while on a call:

- To return to the original call, press send again.

Sending Calls to Voicemail

Ignoring a call sends the caller directly to voicemail, and stops the incoming call ringtone. Use one of these methods to ignore an incoming call:

- Press the Left Soft Key Quiet to silence the ringer.
- Press ox TXT to send the call to voicemail, and choose a pre-entered phrase to send as a text message, or create a new text message to send to the caller.
- Press the Right Soft Key lgnore to send the call to voicemail.

Voicemail

Setting Up Voicemail:

- From the Home screen, press the Messaging Key > Voicemail.
- On the Voicemail screen, view the number of new messages. Press Call to dial voicemail to check messages, or press the Left Soft Key Clear to clear the voicemail counter.

Adding a New Contact

- 1. From the Home screen, press the **Right Soft Key** Contacts.
- 2. Press the Right Soft Key Options > New Contact.
- **3.** Use the keypad to enter a name for the contact in the **Name:** field.
- 4. Use the Directional Key to highlight Mobile 1, Home, Business, Mobile 2, or Fax and enter at least one telephone number.
- **5.** Continue using the **Directional Key** to move to fields to add additional information, if desired.
- **6.** When you're finished entering information, press **Save** to save the contact.

Text Messaging

- 1. From the Home screen, press the Messaging Key > New Message > TXT Message.
- 2. At the New TXT Msg screen, enter recipients in the To: fields:
 - Use the keypad to enter a recipient's phone number, contact name, or Email address. As you enter characters, matching contacts display in a list. Use the Directional Key to highlight a contact, then press Ok.
 - Press the Right Soft Key Add to select recipients:
 - From Contacts: Choose contacts from the Contacts List.
 - Recent Calls: Choose numbers from Recent Calls.
 - Favorites: Choose contacts you have marked as Favorites.
 - Groups: Choose a contacts Group.
 - To Contacts: If a recipient is not saved to contacts, you can save it as a new contact or update an existing one.
- Use the Directional Key to move to the Text: field to compose your message.
- 4. While entering text, press the Right Soft Key Options for these options:
 - Insert Quick Text
 - · Save As Draft
 - Copy
 - Paste
 - Add
 - Format Text
 - · Priority Level
 - · Callback #
 - · Cancel Message
- **5.** Press Send, or to send the message.

Taking Pictures

1. From the Home screen, press the Camera Key on the right side of the phone.

– or –

From the Home screen, press the Left Soft Key

- > Menu > Media Center > Pictures > Take Picture.
- 2. Set Options, if desired.
- Using the display screen as a viewfinder, compose your picture by aiming the lens at your subject.
- 4. Press the Camera Key or Take to take the picture.
- **5.** After taking a photo, use the soft keys for these options:
 - Press the **Right Soft Key Erase** to delete the new photo.
 - Press Send to resize the new photo and attach it to a new picture message.
 - Press the Left Soft Key Save to save the picture to My Pictures.
